## **FOUNDATION HIGHLIGHTS**

How many women do you know, who have been affected by cancer? The statistics mirror what we instinctively know; that 1 in 3 women are at risk of developing and 1 in 5 in dying of cancer in their lifetime. Feel Beautiful Today®, is a 501(c)(3) non-profit foundation that was established in September of 2010, with the singular mission of providing love, hope and encouragement to women and girls affected by cancer. The organization partners with cancer centers and hospitals who are focused on providing "Integrative Oncology" -- an approach that looks at the whole patient; body, mind and spirit. FBT is staffed entirely by volunteers, which enables the organization to invest more than 90% of the donations received into fulfilling its mission. Since 2010, FBT has delivered its programs to more than 4,000 women and girls affected by cancer.




## **PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

FBT offers workshop events at local hospitals, cancer centers, cancer support groups, and rehab centers free-of-charge for patients, caregivers, and family members. Whether the patient is hospitalized or just waiting for treatment for the day, we provide an opportunity for stress relief and a calm atmosphere where they can focus on creativity and beauty rather than their health concerns. **The workshops complement the cancer center and hospitals' efforts to help the overall mental and physical health of their patients.** 

The entire process provides the patients and their family members with a sense of accomplishment – especially those who have never created jewelry. If the patients are feeling well enough, they are encouraged to leave their hospital rooms to work on making some beautiful jewelry for themselves or others. They begin by picking out one of our designs – each is based on a story of encouragement. The materials are pre-sorted by local community volunteers and the kit contains everything needed to assemble the piece. No prior experience is necessary and most patients finish in the allotted time. For those who need some help, our volunteers show them how and let them complete the project. Their completed bracelet is then placed in an organza bag with an inspirational message and packaged inside their "Box of Love."

#### **PROGRAMS**

#### **Boxes of Love**

FBT partners with corporations, individuals and service groups willing to sponsor workshops in homes, schools, office settings, and community centers. Workshop participants are encouraged to make a donation to cover the cost of the materials. This is the primary source of income for the organization and defrays the cost of bringing patient workshops to cancer treatment centers. The pieces created in community workshops are donated and delivered to one of a dozen partner-in-kind beneficiaries in the Atlanta metro area.

#### **Workshops for Patients**

FBT also provides the programs directly to patients who are battling cancer along with their caregivers at local hospitals, cancer centers, cancer support groups, and rehab centers. Whether the patient is hospitalized or just waiting for treatment for the day, we can provide a little stress relief and a calm atmosphere where they can focus on creativity and beauty rather than their health concerns and situation. The workshop participants report experiencing a uniquely positive sense of relaxation as they are occupied in "making something" and distracted away from their health crisis for an interval.

#### Joined in Hope

This a new two-stage program in which the caregiver, or a medical staffer, creates one half of a beautiful necklace. Then, the patient creates the second half of the necklace. Designed with pearls and crystals in a unique design symbolizing their journey. The two pieces are then joined by a beautiful charm; united as a representation of their hope and commitment.
