Marietta, Georgia – Sept 1, 2011 – Every day, 46 children are diagnosed with childhood cancer in the United States. Unknown to many are the facts that children are afflicted by different types of cancers than adults, childhood cancer is the number one disease killer of children ages 0-15 in the U.S., and that childhood cancer research is severely underfunded each year.
